Michael and Stanley will throw a party at Love Books in Melville, Johannesburg on October 2. Another party will be held in Knysna at a date yet to be arranged.



To us, what is really interesting about the outing of JK Rowling as the author of the mystery novel *THE CUCKOO'S CALLING* is the fact that it had only sold about 1500 copies before the news became public. It had been well reviewed, etc., but was going nowhere. When she became known as the author, the book became No. 1 on Amazon.

This doesn't bode well for authors who are not well known, because it implies that sales are linked more directly to who writes a book rather than how good the book is.

It also links to the impression shared by most authors that publishers devote most of their marketing and publicity budgets to a few well known authors, leaving the majority of smaller authors with very little to work with.


The question then, of course, is how do lesser known authors get better known?

If you can find the answer to this, bottle it, sell it, and you will be very RICH.


